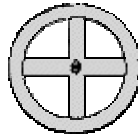

Words from the New Member Educator

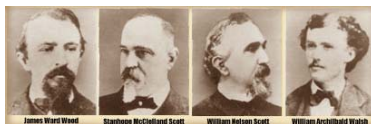
